Proposition A	Earned Sick Time & Minimum Wage Increase	Allows all workers in Missouri to earn 1 hour of sick time for every 30 hours worked. Increases minimum wage to \$15/hour by 2027 with automatic increases tied to the Consumer Price Index.	YES Endorsement
